Special Education Students

Parents should bring their children directly to the Church from their homes for any Religious function that we have throughout the school year. You know that we are always happy to have your children participate. We are aware of the fact that since many of you come long distances it may be easier for you to attend your own church services as a family on days such as Ascension Thursday and The Immaculate Conception. If you join us on Ash Wednesday then you should go directly to your classrooms or to the GYM if that would better meet the needs of your child.

The only exception to the above suggestion is our May Procession. We would like for all our children to participate in the May Procession if that is convenient for the family.

For the May Procession the children should come to their assigned classrooms at the regular time.

The students will be brought to the gym by their Teachers for the May Procession. Parents are asked to go to the Gym and join us for the May Procession. **After the May Procession the children will be dismissed by their Teachers.**

Thursday , May 24, will be the last class for our Special Education Students.

Ash Wednesday falls on February 22, 2012 this year.

We are asking all of the children to come on **Ash Wednesday, February 22, 2012 instead of Thursday , February 23**, of that week so that they can get ashes and take part in a prayer service for the beginning of Lent. Parents are invited to attend the Prayer Service and get Ashes.

Afternoon Session Students should come to their regular assigned classrooms on **Wednesday**, February 22, 2012 , at 4:30PM. Ashes will be distributed in Church within a Prayer Service @ 4:45PM. **All parents and extended family members are strongly encouraged to participate.**

The Students should not bring their books to class on Ash Wednesday All students will be dismissed from **Father Curran Hall** when The ceremony is over.

Ash Wednesday (Continued)

Evening Session Students should report to their assigned classrooms at the regular time.

Ashes will be distributed within a Prayer Service @ 7:05PM in the **GYM in the Upper School**.

Parents and extended family members are strongly encouraged to participate.

All students will be dismissed from **The Gym in the Upper School** @8:15PM or when the 7:30PM Mass is over in the Church.
(We promise to supervise your children until Mass is over if you choose to attend Mass)

The students in the Evening Session are asked to bring their textbooks to class on Ash Wednesday.

May Procession will be on Thursday, May 03, 2012 this year.

Afternoon Session Students should report to their assigned classrooms at the regular time, 4:30PM. We will go over to Church as a group and be ready to begin the May Procession at 4:45PM. **All Parents and extended family members are strongly encouraged to participate.**

Each student is asked to bring their Rosary to the May Procession.. All students will be dismissed from **Father Curran Hall** after the May Procession is over.

The students **do not need** to bring their textbooks to class that afternoon..

Evening Session Students should report to their assigned classrooms in the Upper School, @ the regular time.

Each student is asked to bring their Rosary to class that night.

At 7:10 PM we will begin our May Procession in the Gym of the Upper School.

All Parents and extended family members are strongly encouraged to participate.

After the May Procession the children will be dismissed by their Teachers.

Examinations:

Mid-Term Examinations will be administered during class time on Thursday, January 26th, 2012 for Students in grades three, four, five and six.

Final Examinations will be administered during class to the students in grade three , four, five and Six only on Thursday , May 10th 2012.

Examination Results:

Results of the examinations will be given to the children. Parents will be notified by mail if your child failed the examination. Parents please review your child's work , sign the examination and have your child return it to his/ her Teacher.

Inclement Weather, School Closings and Early Dismissal
